NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The organizing authority (OA) is the Newport Harbor Yacht Club (NHYC).
- 1.3 *Alterations to the Rules – All changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.*
 - 1.3.1 Harbor 20 class: RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all H20, L12 and Finn boats. Five boats will be required to entitle a class to its own start. Other interested classes are encouraged to contact the NHYC Race Office before Wednesday April 13, 2011 for possible inclusion in the regatta.
- 2.2 Skippers must be members in good standing with their respective yacht clubs and class associations to be eligible to sail in this event.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter online by completing the entry form at www.nhyc.org. There is no entry fee for this regatta.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available at the Newport Harbor Yacht Club on Saturday, May 1st 2010.

5. RACING AREA

- 5.1 All classes will race in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

6. THE COURSES

The courses for all classes will be windward -leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8. TROPHIES

- 8.1 Trophies for the H20, L12 and Finn classes will be awarded Saturday, May 1st 2010 as soon as possible after racing.
- 8.2 The winners of the H20 A and B classes will be awarded the Bill Fundenburg Memorial Trophy.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, RA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
