### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 *ALTERATIONS TO THE RULES.* For all divisions, RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be modified. This change will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to the following classes: Men's, Women's A & B, Mixed C, & Clydesdale.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form online (<u>www.nhyc.org</u>) and returning it along with the \$30 entry fee to Newport Harbor Yacht Club (NHYC) on or before April 19, 2015.
- 2.3 A representative from each boat must check-in with the regatta desk at NHYC on Sunday, April 19<sup>th</sup> between 10:00-11:30.

#### 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available upon check-in at NHYC.

#### 5. RACING

- 5.1 Racing will take place in the harbor north of the Main Dock of NHYC.
- 5.2 Courses will be windward -leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course.

#### 6. SCORING

- 6.1 Three races are scheduled of which one is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 6.3 A boat's total score will be the total of her races scores.

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
