Notice of Race

October 15-16, 2016
Organizing Authority: Newport Harbor Yacht Club

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required. This change will appear in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 US Sailing Prescriptions 60, 63.2, and 63.4 will be deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all Lehman 12 boats.
- 2.2. The fleet will sail in two divisions, A and B. The Lehman 12 Board reserves the right to re-assign the entries.
- 2.3. Boats will be allowed to be sailed single-handed; however boats and crews must still meet class-mandated weight requirements.
- 2.4. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form online at www.nhyc.org. All entries must be received by the competitors' meeting.

4. MEASUREMENT REQUIREMENTS

- 4.1 The following measurements will be taken: main sail, crew weight, boat weight.
- 4.2 Boats may be subject to inspection by the class-designated inspector(s) for compliance with class rules at any time during the regatta.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be available at the Newport Harbor Yacht Club on Saturday, October 15.

6. RACING AREA

Racing will be in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

7. SCORING

- 7.1 When five (5) or fewer races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 7.2 A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8. TROPHIES

- 8.1 Trophies will be awarded Sunday, October 16, 2016 as soon as possible after the last race.
- 8.2 The Barney Lehman Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the first place boat in the "A" division.

9. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race.
