# NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 For the Harbor 20 class only, Rules 44.1 and 44.2 will be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required. This change will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 US Sailing Prescriptions 60, 63.2, and 62.4 will be deleted.

# 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all Lehman 12, Harbor 20, and Finn boats.
- 2.2. Skippers must be members in good standing with their respective yacht club and their respective class association to be eligible to sail in this event.
- 2.3. The Harbor 20 fleet will sail in three divisions: A, B and C.
- 2.4. The L-12 class will be allowed to sail single-handed, however boats and crews must still meet class-mandated weight requirements.
- 2.5. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the \$30 entry fee online, <a href="www.nhyc.org">www.nhyc.org</a>, by 1159 on Friday 3/4/16. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been paid. All entry fees are non-refundable.

#### 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 5. RACING AREA

Racing will be in the harbor north of the Main Dock of the Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

### 6. SCORING

- One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 6.2 When four (4) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

#### 7. TROPHIES

7.1. Trophies will be awarded Sunday, March 6, 2016 as soon as possible after the last race. The W. D. Schock Memorial Trophy will be award to the top finishers in the Harbor 20 A, B and C Fleets.
