

# 2016 Summer Twilight Series

Hosted by Newport Harbor Yacht Club THURSDAY EVENINGS IN JUNE, JULY, AUGUST NOTICE OF RACE

## 1. RULES

- 1.1 Each series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 For all Harbor 20 boats: RRS 44.1 and 44.2 will be modified. This change will appear in full in the sailing instructions.
- 1.3 US Sailing prescriptions 60, 63.2 and 63.4 will be deleted.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

- 2.1 Each monthly series is open to all Harbor 20 and Lehman 12 boats.
- 2.2 The Harbor 20 (H20) class will have three (3) divisions, A, B, and C. The Lehman 12 (L12) class will have two (2) divisions, A and B.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter online at <u>www.nhyc.org</u> by completing the entry form prior to a boat's first race. Eligible boats need only enter once to be included in each monthly series.
- 2.4 Sail number changes must be reported in writing to the Race Office, prior to racing with the new sail number.

#### 3. SCHEDULE

## 4. VENUE AND COURSES

Races will be conducted in the harbor north of the NHYC Main Dock. The courses for all classes will be windward-leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course.

## 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available by 1200 hours on Thursday June 11<sup>th</sup> on the online notice board (<u>www.nhyc.org</u>) and at Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

## 6. SCORING

- 6.1 Each monthly series (June, July, and August) will be scored separately.
- 6.2 Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A9. Three (3) races shall be completed to constitute a series.

When 'X' number of races have been completed	A boat's series score will be the total of her races scores excluding 'X" number of scores
4 or fewer	0
5 - 7	1
8 - 10	2
11 or more	3
