## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. US Sailing Prescription 60, 63.2, 63.4 are deleted.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to all Star and Finn class boats that are in good standing with their respective class association.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the \$50 (Star) or \$25 (Finn) entry fee online at [www.nhyc.org](http://www.nhyc.org).
- 2.3. All entries shall be submitted on the Official Online Entry Form available at [www.nhyc.org](http://www.nhyc.org) not later than June 17<sup>th</sup>.
- 2.4. For the purpose of RRS Appendix A Scoring: A competitor is not considered an entry until all fees are paid.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

### 6. VENUE

Racing will be conducted in the Pacific Ocean off Newport Beach.

### 7. COURSES

The courses for all classes will be windward - leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course.

### 8. SCORING

- 8.1. Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.2. When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

### 9. PRIZES

- 9.1. For the Star class, the Baxter Bowl, a perpetual trophy, will be awarded to the winning boat in the Star Class.
- 9.2. Take-home prizes will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each class.

### 10. DISCLAIMER

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
