# NOTICE OF RACE

## 1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, including Appendix U.
- 1.2. RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one tack and one gybe are required.
- 1.3. US Sailing prescription RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all female NHYC members, dependants, and spouses. The OA reserves the right to invite additional non-member competitors at its discretion.
- 2.2. The regatta will be sailed in three fleets A, B and C. Competitors may enter as a Skipper, Crew, or 'Ride Along'. The OA will assign skippers to each fleet based on ability and input from the skipper.
- 2.3. The entry fee for this regatta is \$35 per person; this includes lunch, and post racing snacks.
- 2.4. Completed entry forms and complete payment must be filed with Newport Harbor Yacht Club at [www.nhyc.org](http://www.nhyc.org) by 1700 on May 29<sup>th</sup>.

## 5. RACING AREA

Racing will be conducted in Newport Harbor.

## 6. FORMAT

The format of this regatta will be determined by the OA based on the number of entries.

## 7. SCORING

- 7.1 One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.2 When four (4) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

## 8. TROPHIES

- 8.1 Trophies will be awarded Saturday, June 3, as soon as possible after the last race.
- 8.2 The Bettina Bents Memorial Trophy will be awarded to the winning crew.

**9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
