## NOTICE OF RACE

---

### 1. GENERAL

- 1.1. The 2017 NHYC Opening Day Race is hosted and organized by the Newport Harbor Yacht Club (OA).
- 1.2. The rating authority (RA) for this race is So Cal PHRF.
- 1.3. The series will utilize a "pursuit" or reverse handicap start. A boat's PHRF RLC rating will be used for the purpose of handicapping and assigning start times.
- 1.4. The term Skipper as used herein is defined as the person, whether or not the owner of the boat, is designated on the application for entry--and if the boat is subsequently entered in the race, on the entry form--as "Skipper" and who is the person in charge of the boat during the race. The Skipper is responsible for the boat, its handling and safety, the conduct of its crew before, during, and after the race, and compliance with the rules. The term Competitor as used herein is defined as any person who will be aboard an entered boat during the race. A boat's crew is the full complement of Competitors including the Skipper.

### 2. RULES

- 2.1. The Opening Day Race is governed by the rules as described in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 2.2. The Marine Industry Racer (MIR) rule of PHRF of Southern California does not apply to this regatta.
- 2.3. RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, are required.
- 2.4. US Sailing Prescriptions 63.2, and 62.4 are deleted.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The race is open to all monohull sailboats with a valid So Cal PHRF certificate and a base RLC rating of 125 or lower.
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter the Opening Day Race by completing the online entry form (available at [www.nhyc.org](http://www.nhyc.org)) and submitting a valid 2017 So Cal PHRF certificate before 1700h on Thursday, May 4<sup>th</sup>. **Entries CLOSE @ 1700 on Thursday, May 4<sup>th</sup>. NO LATER ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
- 3.3. There is no entry fee for this race.

### 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS, START TIMES AND CLASS BREAKS

- 5.1. Boats will be assigned starting times by the RC based on their PHRF RLC rating. These starting times will be made available as an attachment to the Sailing Instructions.
- 5.2. Sailing Instructions, including start times and class breaks (if any), will be made available on the official online notice Board ([www.nhyc.org](http://www.nhyc.org)) on Friday, May 5th by 1500. Provisional start times may be posted prior to that date.

## **6. COURSE AREA AND CHECK-IN**

- 6.1. The Opening Day Race will start in Long Beach harbor at approximately 33 43.9 N, 118 08.0 W and finish in the vicinity of the Newport Pier. A detailed course description will be provided in the sailing instructions.
- 6.2. The course will be a random leg course as defined by PHRF and will be approximately 14 miles.
- 6.3. All boats must check-in with the RC signal boat via VHF Channel 5 at least 30 minutes before her starting signal. Specific check-in procedures will be described in full in the SI. Failure to check-in will result in a score of DNC for that race without a hearing.

## **7. SCORING AND PRIZES**

- 7.1. A boat's race score will be her order of finish.
- 7.2. The Opening Day Race Trophy will be awarded to the first place boat.

## **8. DISCLAIMER**

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
