NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 Each series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Harbor 20 boats only: RRS 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one tack and one gybe are required.
- 1.3 US Sailing prescriptions 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

- 2.1 Each monthly series is open to all Harbor 20 and Lehman 12 boats.
- 2.2 The Harbor 20 (H20) class will have three (3) divisions, A, B, and C. The Lehman 12 (L12) class will have two (2) divisions, A and B.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter online at www.nhyc.org by completing the entry form prior to a boat's first race. Eligible boats need only enter once to be included in each monthly series.
- 2.4 Sail number changes must be reported in writing to the Race Office, prior to racing with the new sail number.

3. SCHEDULE

4. VENUE AND COURSES

Races will be conducted in the harbor north of the NHYC Main Dock. The courses for all classes will be windward-leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available no later than 1200 on Thursday, May 23rd on the online notice board (www.nhyc.org) and at Newport Harbor Yacht Club.

6. SCORING

- 6.1 Each monthly series (May, June, July, and August) will be scored separately.
- 6.2 Scoring will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A9. Three (3) races shall be completed to constitute a series.

When 'X' number of races have been completed	A boat's series score will be the total of her races scores excluding 'X' number of scores
4 or fewer	0
5 - 7	1
8 - 10	2
11 or more	3
