NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
 1.2 For the Harbor 20 classes only, Rules 44.1 and 44.2 will be changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to Lehman 12, Lido 14, Harbor 20, Schock 35, and Santana 20 boats. Five (5) boats are required to constitute a class eligible for a start and trophies. Other interested One-Design classes may be invited to sail at the sole discretion of the OA and are encouraged to contact the NHYC Race Director prior to February 19, 2012.
 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and paying the entry fee online at www.nhyc.org.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available upon check-in at NHYC.

6. RACING AREAS

- Bay Classes (Lido 14, Lehman 12, Harbor 20,) will race in the harbor north of the NHYC Main Dock.
- Ocean Classes (Schock 35, Santana 20) will race in the Pacific Ocean, in the vicinity of the Newport Pier.

7. THE COURSES

The courses for all classes will be windward-leeward type courses or any variation of a triangular or other course. A leeward gate may be used at the race committee's discretion.

8. SCORING

- 8.1 Two (2) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
 8.2 When five (5) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

9. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

The OA may require boats to carry a supplied tracking device. Failure to carry and operate a tracking device will lead to the cancellation of an entry or disqualification. See RRS 76.1.

10. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to class winners, based on the number of entries, on Sunday, March 4, 2012, as soon as possible after the last race.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
