NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1. This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1. Invited one design classes include J70, J120, and Pac 52. Other one design classes are invited to attend and must make a request in writing to the NHYC Race office (laurel.dinwiddie@nhycstaff.org) before Monday, June 5th, 2017.

3. ENTRY

3.1. Eligible boats may enter online at www.nhyc.org. Entries close Thursday, June 8th at 1700. An entry is not complete until all entry forms, fees, and required measurement certificates are received by the OA.

3.2. The entry fee for this event will be \$125; however, entries submitted on or after Monday, June 5th will be subject to a \$50 late fee.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing instructions will be published no later than 1400 on Thursday, June 8th. These documents will be emailed to each boat as well as posted on the official notice board and on the online notice board (found at www.nhyc.org)

6. RACING AREA

All racing will be conducted in the Pacific Ocean in the waters off of Newport Beach.

7. SCORING

7.1. Scoring will be in accordance with RRS A4.

7.2. For all classes:

- One (1) race is required to constitute a series.
- When four (4) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score shall be the sum of her race scores.

8. PRIZES

8.1. Prizes will be awarded at NHYC to class winners on Sunday, June 11th as soon as possible after the last race.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this race participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (OA, Ratings Authority, Race Committee, Protest Committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this race. By participating in this race, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
