<p>II.D. Class Championship Race Participation Requirements</p>	<p>This Notice of Race (NOR) incorporates changes to the Class Rules which are in effect at the time of issuance of the NOR. In accordance with Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 87, the written permission of the Class Association for these changes was obtained per Class By-laws provision I.D.14 (i.e., 2/3rd majority vote of all Board Members) and is included on the on-line official notice board for the Championship.</p> <p>Registrants shall ensure their Class membership is accurately shown by February 15, 2019, in the membership roster at <a href="http://harbor20.org">harbor20.org</a> under the Members - Member Roster option.</p>
<p>II.D.1. Championship races are special events for boat owners. For Class Championships, the Helmsman must be an Owner Member who has been a member for over 60 days. In the case of multiple Owner Members, the Helmsman is the one who signs the entry form.</p>	<p>Class rule II.D.1 is replaced by the following:</p> <p>For Class Championships, the Helmsman must meet the requirements to sail in his or her Fleet Championship, as documented in the respective Fleet bylaws and/or Notice of Race issued by the Fleet(s). If the Fleet does not have established requirements, a Helmsman from that Fleet must be an Owner Member who has been a member for over 60 days. In the case of multiple Owner Members, the Helmsman is the one who signs the entry form.</p>
<p>II.D.2. Omitted</p>	<p>No change.</p>
<p>II.D.3. The crew for Class Championship must be a person who meets the basic principles and intent of these rules (Section II.A.4), and they must have sailed in at least twelve Class Races in the same boat during the time period between the last Class Championship Series and the Class Championship Series under consideration. Paid professional sailors and full-time sailing coaches must have been retired for at least three full years.</p>	<p>Class rule II.D.3 is replaced by the following:</p> <p>The crew for Class Championship must be a person who meets the basic principles and intent of these rules (Section II.A.4), and who is an Owner, Skipper or Associate Member of the Class, and who has sailed in at least twelve (12) Fleet or Class Races in the twelve months starting March 1, 2018. Paid professional sailors and full-time sailing coaches must have been retired for at least three full years.</p> <p>Crew registrants shall submit an e-mail certification from their Fleet Captain that the 12-race requirement is satisfied.</p>

II.D.4. Only the Helmsman shall steer the boat during a race except for momentary relief in nontactical situations.	No change.
II.D.5. It is intended that strict adherence to the rules specified in this section be maintained. However, a member with special circumstances, may petition the Class or Fleet Board for a variance in these II.D Rules using the provisions of I.D.15. This should be done well in advance of the event.	Class rule II.D.5 is replaced by the following:  It is intended that strict adherence to the rules specified in this section be maintained. However, a member with special circumstances may petition the Class Board for a variance in these II.D Rules using the provisions of I.D.14. The petition must be emailed to the Class President and Measurer by February 15, 2019.
II.D.6. The Class Measurer may require the first five finishers be inspected at the finish of each race.	No change.
